48,XXYY: Tell us about your quality of life!

Study Name

“The Relationship of Physical Function and Psychosocial Health on Quality of Life in Men with 48,XXYY”

What is the study about?

We want to learn more about how men with 48,XXYY describe their own physical health, psychosocial health, and quality of life.

Who can participate?

Men at least 18 years old with a non-mosaic 48,XXYY diagnosis. In addition, participants need to have completed at least 6th grade education, have access to a computer and telephone, and speak English.

What is involved?

You will complete 3 online surveys about your physical and psychological health, and quality of life. After this, you may be randomly selected to participate in an informal interview, over the phone, about your healthcare needs and your thoughts on your quality of life. Participant compensation for your time is between \$50-100, depending on survey completion and random interview selection.
